Starting with raw aluminium, he heats, hammers, saws, welds and polishes each piece by hand, making each figure unique. Marcus Egli creates aluminium figures which he calls "Hominium".

The exhibition will display thousands of Marcus's "Hominium's". These sculpted figures, often generic, can be found in rows, lines, blocks, some in cages, others discarded, the artworks illustrate Marcus' concern with freedom and the movement and treatment of people.

Marcus Egli was born in Zurich in 1957. Marcus spent part of his youth drifting happily and was offered a bursary at Art College to study manual arts. Before taking up his place at college he travelled to America, and on his return to Switzerland realised that he valued his independence too much and decided to set up his own studio. With his wife Rita he bought a small aluminium forge and workshop, where he was finally able to indulge in his lifelong passion of creating with his hands. At Woolff gallery we are preparing for nearly 3.5 tons of Marcus' unique aluminium artworks.

This will be Marcus Egli's first solo exhibition in the UK.















